Rally Obedience

6 week course beginning July 7th

Rally Obedience is a quickly growing and very popular dog sport that is fun and exciting for the owner and the dog!

Rally is described as a combination of agility and obedience. Dogs and their handlers are required to follow a specific course of 10-20 signs while performing various obedience skills that are listed on the signs around the course. Topics covered in the class will include the basics of rally, how to read course maps, and correct performance of rally signs.

Rally Obedience is a great way to continue to work on obedience skills while trying a new sport with your dog.

Canine Good Citizen

6 week course beginning July 12th OR July 14th

TUESDAYS AT 7:30PM

THURSDAYS AT 10:30AM

Cost: \$165

The American Kennel Club started the Canine Good Citizen program in 1989. CGC is a certification program that is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. In Canine Good Citizen, dogs who pass the 10 step test can earn a certificate and/or the official American Kennel Club Canine Good Citizen title. Dogs with the Canine Good Citizen title have the suffix, "CGC" after their names.

This six week class prepares you and your dog for every item in the ten step test. The dog must already have an understanding of basic commands and reliable with other dogs and distractions. On week six of the class, the Canine Good Citizen test is administered.

Basic Manners I

Beginner's Obedience is a 6 week class designed for dogs with no previous formal training or those who are interested in learning about positive reinforcement training methods. We will use clicker training and positive reinforcement to teach the dogs to sit, down, stay, come, leave it, focus, settle, touch as well as how to walk nicely on leash (no pulling) and greet people and other dogs politely

This is a great training starting point for dogs' ages 5 months and up.

Prerequisite: For friendly dogs who have current rabies, distemper, and bordatella vaccines
